Suggestions for playing:

Option A (more competitive)


In a small group setting, give each student at the table a copy of the same board (CVC Words, for example).

Give each student a small playing piece (mini eraser, math cube, etc.).

Pair students so that they can "race". Students start reading their board at the same time. Teacher listens and corrects any misreads.

Option B (less competitive)

Each student works alone in small group, large group, or reading centers. The student will place a small playing piece on their board and then "race" to see how quickly they can read all of the words.
