Stage 1

Year 2 School Swimming Scheme

Notes went home with all Year 2 students last term about the Swimming School Scheme. The program is conducted over 10 days, from 6 November to 17 November, at Speers Point Swimming Pool with 45 minute daily lessons. Students who have not reached a satisfactory standard of water safety and survival skills, and are unable to swim 25 metres confidently unaided in deep water are eligible to participate in the program. The cost for the 2 week Swimming Scheme program is \$65. It is limited to 60 students and currently we only have 13 places left. Once the 60 places have been filled a waiting list will be created. Due to the nature of this excursion, online and EFTPOS payments cannot be accepted.

Life Education

Attendance

Student attendance is currently being reviewed. Letters will be sent home to parents for students whose attendance rate falls under 90% for the year. On many occasions the absences have been explained so the letters are to inform parents of their child's attendance rate rather than explanations for absences.

Attendance reminders:

- Our school day commences at 9:10am. Any student who arrives after this time will need to go to the office to receive a late note. This will be noted as a partial attendance.
- Our school day concludes at 3:10pm. If a child needs to leave school early parents/carers need to sign them out at the office. This will be noted as a partial attendance.
- Parents are required to provide the school with an explanation for any student absence. This can be in the form of a written note, Skoolbag absent entry or verbally to the teacher or office.
- If a child is going to be absent from school due to a medical procedure please inform your child's teacher prior to the day so that an exemption from school application can be completed.

General Notices

Reminder from Transport for NSW

Applications for 2018 School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) and Term Bus Pass (TBP) travel entitlements are now open.

In coming days students who hold an SSTS entitlement and are changing grade bands i.e. going from year 2 to 3 or year 6 to 7 and changing school, and students whose entitlement was approved under a medical condition,

will receive notification by email or post informing them of the pending expiry of their entitlement. TBP holders will also receive notification.

Students enquiring about pending cancellation should be advised to go online to <u>https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails</u> to update details/make application for next year's entitlement.

Application needs to be made before 31 December 2017 to ensure their entitlement is updated and their current card is not cancelled. If application is made after the expiry of their entitlement (31 December) the system will automatically cancel their card and a new one will need to be issued.

Please note: Students who are changing grade band and are <u>remaining at the same school</u> will not receive notification and <u>do not need to reapply</u> (the system now automatically validates a student's on-going eligibility if at the same school and going from infants to primary or primary to secondary). Where a student meets the new eligibility the system will automatically update their entitlement and card.

Students in the Opal area applying for a SSTS or TBP entitlement for the first time will receive their card (posted to the nominated address) a week or two before the commencement of 2018 classes. Please let students know new cards for 2018 are not posted in 2017 or during the Christmas / New Year period.

Students residing in Rural and Regional (R&R) areas are expected to receive their new travel pass at the commencement of the New School Year. **Note**; not all R&R operators issue passes (often in smaller communities where the student is known a pass is not issued).

Dear Parent/Carer

Selective high schools cater for high achieving academically gifted students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. These schools help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level.

Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on Thursday 15 March 2018.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2019, you need to apply soon. You will need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available from 10 October 2017 in a printed application information booklet and at <u>https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7</u>.

The application website opens at <u>https://education.nsw.gov.au/selective-high-schools-and- opportunity-</u> <u>classes/year-7</u> on 10 October 2017 and closes on 13 November 2017. You must apply before the closing date.

There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Unit for assistance after 10 October 2017.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.
