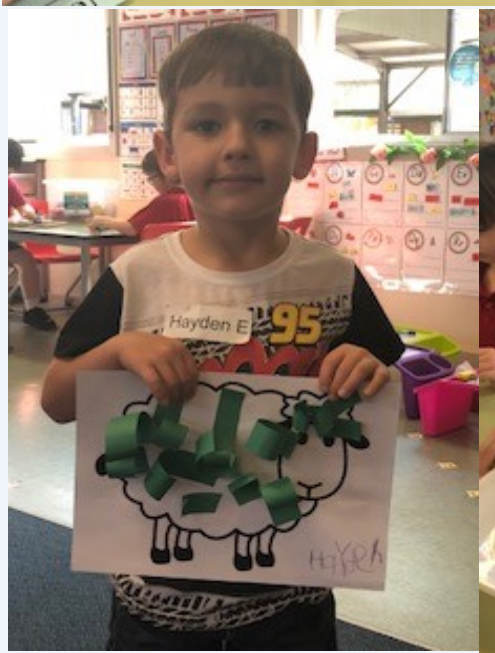

This term, a Police Liaison Officer visited the school to answer any questions students might have about road safety as a pedestrian, rider or passenger.



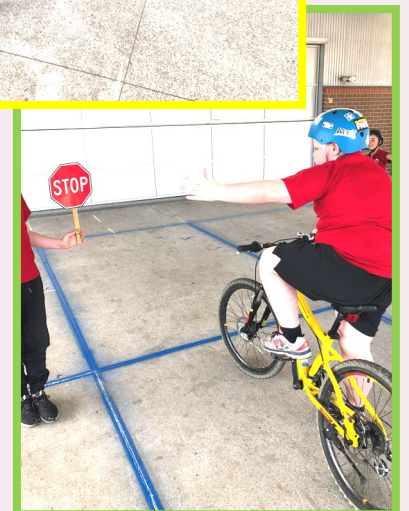
Road Safety

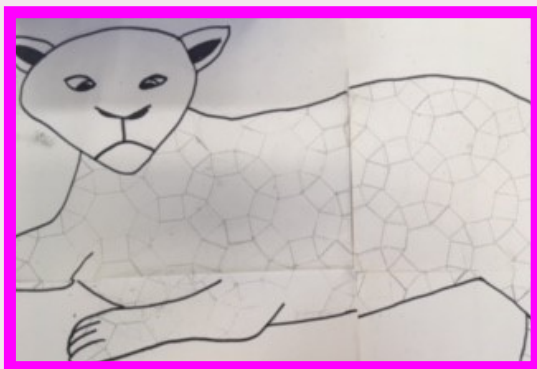


2/3T in the Spotlight

The students have also been turning heads with their terrific tessellated patterns. They have been drawing their own on whiteboards and manipulating shapes on the iPad to create their own unique patterns.

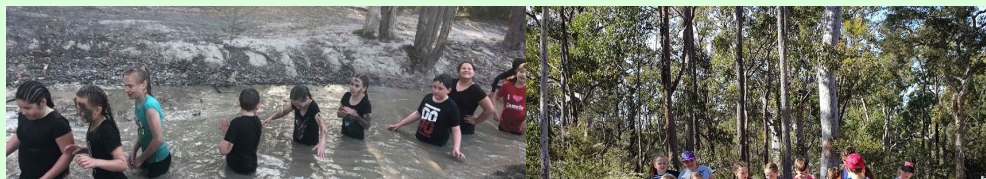


Throughout the term, we have been collaboratively working on a representing the tough skin of a crocodile and the spotty fur of a jaguar to link with our literacy focus.
